

## Temporary International Presence in Hebron (TIPH)

### Job description

#### **1.1. Observer (OBS)**

**Division:** Operations Division (OPD)

**Reports to:** HOP/DHOP and DO

#### **Duties and Responsibilities for OBS**

- Patrol in the Area of Responsibility ( AOR) in shifts decided by HOP/DHOP, 7 days a week
- Collect information and register incidents deemed significant with regard to TIPH's mandate
- Write reports on potential violations of the Hebron related agreements, International Humanitarian Law and International Human Rights Law, reporting directly to HOP/DHOP when necessary
- After three months of work, Observers may apply for vacant internal positions

#### **Required Qualifications**

##### **Educational Background**

- Police/military academy/basic training or a Bachelor degree with a specialization on Middle Eastern studies
- Some management training preferred

##### **Practical Experience**

- Minimum 5 years police/military background or a civilian background with minimum 5 years of relevant work experience
- Experience from International Mission is an asset
- Computer literacy

##### **Language Proficiency Required**

- A good working knowledge of English, both spoken and written
- A good working knowledge of Arabic and/or Hebrew, both spoken and written, for applicants with civilian academic background
- Working knowledge of Arabic and/or Hebrew is an asset for applicants with police or military background
